ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The **SPARC Scholars** Fund is housed at The Greater Washington Community Foundation (GWCF). The Fund is administered through The Community Foundation in Montgomery County, an affiliate of GWCF.

The Fund was created by an anonymous family to provide scholarships to youth who display a passion – whether in athletics, the arts or other areas – as well as a commitment to succeed academically. Scholarship awards are intended to enable rising 6 – 12 grade students attend private schools within the Washington Metropolitan Region.

AWARD AVAILABILITY

Awardees of the **SPARC Scholars** Fund may receive up to \$7,500 annually to attend a private school in the Washington Metropolitan Region. Students may be eligible for renewal scholarship grants in subsequent years if they continue to pursue academic and extra-curricular achievement. Scholarship winners who demonstrate great accomplishments throughout middle and high school may be eligible to apply for continued scholarship support as they pursue higher education.

Please note that this is a highly competitive selection process. Only a few students will be selected each year to receive scholarships.

ELIGIBILITY

You may be eligible if you:

- Have demonstrated a considerable interest in extra-curricular activities and academic promise;
- Are a member of a family with significant financial need;
- Are a rising middle or high school student entering 6 – 12 grade in the next academic year;
- Are a resident of Washington Metropolitan Region*; and
- Are applying to or are currently enrolled in a private/independent school within the Washington Metropolitan Region.

*The Washington Metropolitan Region is considered Maryland, Virginia and/or Washington DC.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be considered on the basis of need and general quality of the application, with preference given to those who demonstrate interest and drive to succeed academically and in their outside pursuits.



CHECKLIST OF MATERIALS

Please note that applications must be submitted with all of the following components. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- Signed application form.
- A brief personal statement (refer to the enclosed Personal Statement form).
- A copy of your school transcripts.
- At least two letters of recommendation*:
 - One from a coach/trainer, teacher or mentor who can attest to your commitment in your area of interest (e.g., sports, music, etc.).
 - One from a teacher, instructor, mentor or other adult who can attest to your academic achievements.

Please note that recommendations may not be completed by family members.
- A copy of your recent family income statement submitted to the private school as part of your application **OR** the enclosed Financial Need Statement.
- A Tuition and Financial Aid Worksheet (refer to enclosed form).
- A copy of your financial aid award letter from the school you wish to attend. This is the letter from the school which states the exact amount your family is responsible to pay for the coming school year.

*If you are in the process of applying to a private/independent school, you may submit the same letters of recommendation prepared for the school's application. You may also opt to submit original letters specifically geared for the **SPARC Scholars** scholarship.

We also understand that in addition to tuition, you will incur other school-related expenses for things such as books, lessons, field trips, etc. These types of costs will be taken into consideration as well when determining the total amount awarded to each scholarship recipient.

Please note that the Selection Committee will also accept nominations from private schools. School nominations must include a letter of recommendation from the headmaster or senior staff member in the admissions office; a copy of the student's transcript; a letter from a teacher/coach/trainer/mentor who can attest to the student's extra-curricular interests and academic promise; a copy of the student's recent family income statement; and a copy of the financial aid award letter from the school which states the exact amount the family is responsible to pay for the coming school year.



APPLICATION DEADLINE: May 1st

All applications and attachments must be emailed by Friday, May 1st. Applications must be emailed to the address below. Please note that faxes, hand-delivered, and mailed applications will not be accepted.

NOTIFICATION & FOLLOW UP

Students will be notified of their application status by June 16th. Scholarship winners will be required to provide proof of enrollment by July 1st. Students who do not enroll in private school or fail to submit the necessary documentation will forfeit their scholarship for the year. Each year, scholarship winners will be expected to provide documentation of their academic progress and involvement in extra-curricular activities to the *SPARC Scholars* Selection Committee in order to be considered for renewal scholarship grants.
